School Announcements

Topic: Spring Water Safety (for use during spring thaw). Below are 5 announcements, one announcement for each day of the school week during spring thaw.

- 1. A springtime safety reminder from Quinte Conservation...Rivers, creeks and streams in the Quinte Region are swollen with spring runoff. Currents are strong and fast-flowing waters are dangerously cold. Ice on rivers and lakes can be treacherous at this time of year. Stay away from dams, ditches, and culverts. Stay away from water! Be smart and stay safe!
- 2. Remember, stay away from the water this spring and stay safe! A springtime safety reminder from Quinte Conservation... Springtime is a bad time to play near the water. The water is cold and dangerous, and the current is strong. Stay off the ice and away from the slippery shoreline. Be smart and stay safe!
- **3.** A springtime safety reminder from Quinte Conservation... This spring, be smart and stay safe. Don't play near dams, ditches, or culverts. Stream banks are slippery and ice along shores is dangerous too! Remember, when you go out this spring ...Stay away from water! Be smart and stay safe!
- 4. Stay away from dam structures. A springtime safety reminder from Quinte Conservation. Never play around dam structures and never swim near one. Waters currents around a dam can trap you with such force that you cannot escape. Be smart and be safe near fast-flowing waters, ice, and dams.
- 5. A springtime safety reminder from Quinte Conservation. Stay away from fast cold flowing waters including rivers, creeks, streams, ditches, and culverts. Remember, never play near dams, and never play near ice without adult supervision. Be Smart and Stay Safe.
