Staff updated The Board on the work plan, stating that the document is being reviewed after 5 years to address any gaps or inefficiencies in the Source Protection Plan, and to incorporate any growth or infrastructure changes. SWP staff are currently preparing an updated draft of the work plan which will be submitted to the Authority prior to November 30th for approval from The Board.

7. Village of Madoc S34 Amendment Report.

The Board was updated on Madoc's water usage. The suggestion of adding a second well was viewed in favour by the municipality. The suggestion for a second well was consulted through an Environmental Assessment and the Ministry of Environment. A public commenting period will need to take place.

A board member asked if the second well was due to an inadequate supply and whether it would be the same with the new well and if it would be using the same aquifer.

Staff commented that the wells are in fractured rock and that the existing well will be decommissioned
