10. Extending Source Water (Motion to Approve)

Chair of the Source Water Protection Committee (SPC) did a presentation.

A DRAFT letter was presented that the SPC wishes to send to the Director of the Source Protection Branch of the Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks. SPC wants the letter endorsed by the Source Water Protection Authority (SPA).

Staff explained the Clean Water Act.

Board Member asked about chemicals being in water systems and where they come from.

Chair of SPC answered that the chemicals can come from a number of different sources such as gas stations, storage facilities and application of pesticides and insecticides.

Board Member asked about standardizing the regulation between the province and municipality.

Chair of SPC agreed.

Board Member stated that there are several places in Prince Edward County that are on well and septic. The Board Member asked who pays the cost if a risk is identified and action is required.

Chair of SPC stated that the risk cannot be ignored once it is identified but there is no answer to this in the Act.
