

*Canadian Navigable Waters Act*

Quinte Conservation hereby gives notice that a submission has been added to the Navigable Waters Registry pursuant to the Canadian Navigable Waters Act for public comment described herein and its site and plans.

Pursuant to paragraph 10(1)(b) of the said Act,

Quinte Conservation has deposited with the Minister of Transport, on the on-line Common Project Search Registry (<http://cps.canada.ca/>) and under registry number 6444 a description of the following work, its site and plans:

This project will replace the CSP culverts with 3 pre-cast concrete box culverts. At the upstream end of each culvert, the end section will be structured to incorporate vertical channels to enable the installation of removable wooden stoplogs to facilitate flow and water level manipulation. Both flow and water level have been designed to match the historical level.
