Copy of an Order-in-Council approved by His Honour the Lieutenant Governor, dated the 16th day of December, A.D. 1965.

The Committee of Council have had under consideration the report of the Honourable the Minister of Energy and Resources Management, dated December 9th 1965, wherein he states that,

Act resolutions have been received from the Villages of Bloomfield and Wellington and the Townships of Ameliasburgh and Hillier, being four municipalities situate wholly within an area comprising the watersheds of all streams entering Lake Ontario and all bays, channels and reaches thereof, in the County of Prince Edward, requesting the Minister of Energy and Resources Management to call a meeting for the consideration of the establishment of a conservation authority for such watersheds;

and whereas a meeting for the consideration of the establishment of a conservation authority was called for the 2nd day of December, 1965, in the County Council Chambers in the Town of Picton, notice of which was sent by registered letter to the following municipalities:

The Township of Ameliasburgh,
The Township of Athol,
The Village of Bloomfield,
The Township of Hallowell,
The Township of Hillier,
The Township of Marysburgh North,
The Township of Marysburgh South,
The Town of Picton,
The Township of Sophiasburgh,
Village of Wellington;

AND WHEREAS the meeting was held as called and the following municipalities were represented by one representative each:

The Township of Ameliasburgh,
The Village of Bloomfield,
The Township of Hallowell,
The Township of Hillier,
The Township of Marysburgh North,
The Township of Marysburgh South,
The Town of Picton,
The Township of Sophiasburgh,
The Village of Wellington;

AND WHEREAS a resolution was passed unanimously by the nine representatives present, requesting the establishment of a conservation authority for the watersheds of all streams entering Lake Ontaric and all bays, channels and reaches thereof, in the County of Prince Edward;

The Honourable the Minister of Energy and Resources Management therefore recommends that under sections 3 and 5 of The Conservation Authorities Act, a conservation authority be established with jurisdiction over the area comprising the watersheds of all streams entering Lake Ontario and all bays, channels and reaches thereof, in the County of Prince Edward;

And that the conservation authority be known as THE PRINCE EDWARD REGION CONSERVATION AUTHORITY;

And that the participating municipalities in The Prince Edward Region Conservation Authority be:

The Township of Ameliasburgh,
The Township of Athol
The Village of Bloomfield,
The Township of Hallowell,
The Township of Hillier,
The Township of Marysburgh North,
The Township of Marysburgh South,
The Township of Sophiasburgh,
The Township of Sophiasburgh,
The Village of Wellington.

The Committee of Council concur in the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Energy and Resources Management and advise that the same be acted on.
